The community of Yachats, on the Oregon Coast, has scheduled a series of public labyrinth events as preparation for the creation of a new Community Labyrinth next to the Public Library. Marie Green, Chair of Yachats Labyrinth Park Project Task Force, says "after extensive research and thoughtful and lively discussions, the Task Force has found strong interest in creating a labyrinth in Yachats for Yachadians and visiting tourists." Construction is tentatively scheduled for Fall 2011.

Denny Dyke's Circles in the Sand has been rescheduled for Thursday, August 4.

8:00 AM -- Denny Dyke will be making labyrinths on the beach at the south side of the Yachats River, and he will help you create your own beach labyrinth. Bring your own staff, stick or magic wand, and learn how to draw the cretan labyrinth.

Join us on the beach to walk the labyrinth to support the new labyrinth coming to Yachats.

9:00 AM -- Denny Dyke will begin construction of a 50 ft. Santa Rosa Style labyrinth.
