JOIN A VIRTUAL EVENT



Because of COVID-19, this year's World Labyrinth Day will be different from years past. Since 2009, World Labyrinth Day has been celebrated by a variety of walks and events on the first Saturday in May. All over the world, people have walked at 1:00 p.m. in their individual time zones, causing a wave of healing energy to circle the globe. This year a few people will be fortunate to walk a labyrinth near their home alone or with members of their household. The rest of us will walk from home on finger and hand held labyrinths. Two groups we know of will be providing an opportunity to gather virtually while doing this. We want to give you the opportunity to join them.

Members of **Trinity Episcopal Labyrinth Guild** and their community will gather at 12:50 p.m. May 2 on Zoom. The event will begin with a short program led by Sandra Walden and Patricia Newton. It will include instructions for using a finger labyrinth, a history of World Labyrinth Day, and a meditation and slide show of the world we all love. They will then walk a finger labyrinth together accompanied by special music and there will be time for sharing at the end. .

The international labyrinth organization, **Veriditas**, has been holding weekly Zoom finger labyrinth walks every week in April. Each has been attended by over 200 people from all over the world. They are usually on Fridays, but this one will be Saturday May 2 in honor of World Labyrinth Day. The walk will be led by Lars Howlett, an expert in designing labyrinths and other sacred spaces. For those new to finger labyrinths, you will find an introductory video. Once registered, you will be sent an email with a link to join. The event will be held at 12:45 Pacific Time.
