The Aramaic Cycle, created by Saadi (Neil Douglas-Klotz, PhD) consists of 8 dances that take us through the entire Lord's Prayer in Aramaic; the language most scholars believe Jesus spoke. Translations directly from Aramaic, convey depths of meaning often lost in the King James version of the Bible, which was translated from Greek – a language very different from Aramaic. The language allows, requires even, listening and profound attention to receive the meanings that each of us needs each day, just like our daily bread.

**What to wear:** Participants should come in comfortable clothes appropriate for sacred dancing.

**Limited mobility:** Join in Community by witnessing the evening program from a seated position.

No pressure to dance- Anyone can witness or choose to dance!

**Children:** Welcome to participate in labyrinth walk or evening dance- suggested age appropriate 7+- **our only requirements-** Ability to hold sacred space in quiet, as to not disturb the event for others.

### INVESTIGATE-The Lord's Prayer in Aramaic-Workshop details:

Explore the nuances of meaning of the words in Aramaic and engage in body practices that will deepen the experience of the dance. Will include teaching/discussion, seated practices (contemplation, meditation, prayer), and learning/ embodying the dances.

### EXPERIENCE-The Dance of The Aramaic Lord's Prayer Evening Dance details:

Participate in the full cycle of the Aramaic Lord's Prayer. Each of the eight dances are fully taught, briefly rehearsed, and guided.

Participation in the workshop is absolutely NOT required to participate in the dance.
